



Become a Volunteer EMT with Lopez Island Fire and EMS!

Lopez Island Fire and EMS is recruiting students for our Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course starting in January 2023.

- This will be a full certification course of approximately 220-hours.
- Attendance at ALL classes is mandatory.
- Classes will begin January 4, 2023 and finish in late April 2023.
- Classes will be held Wednesday and Friday evenings, as well as Saturday days. Total of 12 class hours per week.

Applicants must:

- Be willing to help others, at all hours, and in all types of weather
- Commit to attending drills and other trainings to maintain certification
- Be 18 years old by completion of the course
- Possess a WA state driver's license.
- Be legally employable
- Hold a High school diploma or have GED equivalency
- Have NO DUI or drug convictions and pass a police background check
- Must provide documentation of Covid-19 vaccination
